**GALATIANS 6:9 - " Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up."**

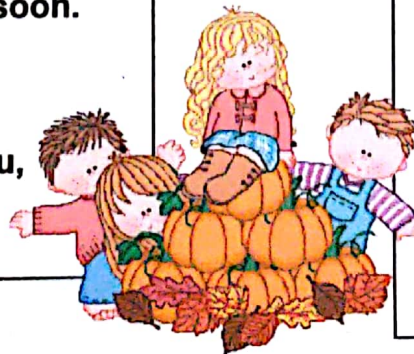
Dear Parents & Caregivers,
